For the 15th Railyard release, label founder Sean Palm returns... as New Zealand's own Simon Flower slices a remix juicier than a fresh Aotearoanian kiwi. Following the licensing of his first solo release to *Loco Dice's Timewarp*, and with his current work with Joel Mull under "The Descent" moniker, Sean Palm continues to display his depth of soul within a 'less-is-more' structure.

From the title song CORIAN, lush sounds are weaved with hypnotic sustaining melodies into a properly delicate structure. With enough body to move, soul to groove, and head to smooth, this slab of New York sonica is possibly Palm's most mature statement to date.

On the flipside, Simon Flower's forward-thinking talent shines consistent with his 2007 appearances on Poker Flat, Moon Harbour and Dessous & Compost. Upbeat funky house meets swinging techno stabs in a mysterious atmosphere of swirling pads. Full in energy yet delicate in touch, this versatile compliment will inspire sets either day or night, start or finish.
